The Black Box tree has white ants, dry rot & split as well as being aged; this is to be confirmed by an arborist. As Black Box trees are protected, expert advice is required as to what action is to be taken.

Meanwhile members are alerted to go to the north side of the tee and not be underneath it, especially in windy conditions.

Also, the dead tree at the fourth tee off will be attended to in the near future.

The Golf Club Committee have taken advice from the Shire representative, La Vergne Lehmann and her advisors as to what course of action is needed to be put in place. The grounds are fabulous & we try to make sure they are safe for any person who steps onto them.

Tree removal & maintenance is takes time so a considered plan of action will be put into place.
